Work Breakdown Structure (WBS) Template

What is Work Breakdown Structure (WBS) Template?

A Work Breakdown Structure (WBS) template is a tool used in project management to decompose a high-level project objective into smaller, manageable tasks that can be planned, executed, and tracked. The WBS template helps to create a hierarchical structure of all the work involved in delivering a project, including its objectives, deliverables, and tasks.

The WBS template typically includes the following elements:

1. **Project Title:** A brief description of the project.
2. **Project Objective:** A clear statement of what the project aims to achieve.
3. **Deliverables:** The final products or results that will be produced by the project.

Under Work Package 2: Design and Prototyping:

- Create high-fidelity design prototypes
- Develop responsive design for mobile devices
- Test and refine the design with stakeholders

1. Clarify the scope of work
2. Identify all the tasks required to deliver the project objective
3. Plan and schedule the project activities
4. Track progress and measure performance
5. Make adjustments and changes as needed
